Golf, the wonders of Friuli Venezia Giulia in a video

PromoTurismoFVG is relying on the world of golf to attract a tourism niche and has made a video that enhances the destination through its "greens"

Trieste, May 31 2021 — there are seven 18 holes "greens" in the region available to members and protagonists of the new video realized and launched by PromoTurismoFVG, the organization that deals with the strategy, operational management and tourism promotion of Friuli Venezia Giulia, with a department entirely dedicated to "food&wine", to enhance the territory also as a tourist destination suitable for golfers.

Friuli Venezia Giulia, the leader of the "Italy Golf&More" project, the national network for the promotion of golf in collaboration with Enit, despite the territory of limited size, allows enthusiasts to train in different contexts that are not far from each other. The video brings together the seven golf courses highlighting the unparalleled choice between different technical characteristics and a variety of natural landscapes. THE GOLF CLUBS OF THE COAST

Starting from the coast, there are two courses in the main seaside resorts of the region, Grado and Lignano Sabbiadoro, for enthusiasts of this sport. The **Golf Club Grado**, surrounded by the lagoon, offers 18 holes in almost sixty hectares in the splendid Tenuta Primero among dense reeds which are the natural habitat of herons, wild swans, flamingos and other wildlife species typical of the lagoon environment. On the other hand, the **Golf Club Lignano** offers the thrill of 18 holes dotted with lakes and bunkers and impressive long fairways, extensive greens (defended by water obstacles) and vast rough natural sand (Arizona), all perfectly nestled among the stretches of water and the lush vegetation of the pine forest for a varied and compelling game.

ON THE HILLS

Climbing the hill, you will find the **Golf & Country Club Castello di Spessa** which winds through the beautiful scenery of the Collio Goriziano vineyards. The course is characterized by various landscapes and differently modelled fairways, giving one the impression of playing in three different places. There is also the **Golf Club Udine**, 18 beautiful holes against the background of hills covered in centuries-old oaks, beech and wild cherry trees, just five kilometres from San Daniele and 18 from Udine. Founded in 1972, the course located in Fagagna, in the heart of the Friuli Morenic hills, best combines the pleasure of playing golf with an exclusive and relaxing landscape.

AT THE FOOT OF THE MOUNTAINS AND ON THE KARST

The **Pordenone Golf Club** has a golf course that harmoniously integrates old and new holes in the hills inside the prestigious Natural Park of Villa Policreti, a residence of particular historical and architectural interest built in the 16th century. Today it is home to an elegant hotel, with a renowned restaurant and the clubhouse that dominates the green expanse of the golf course. Nestled in the unique vegetation of the Karst, the **Golf Club di Trieste:** Is a few minutes from the Slovenian border and overlooks the enchanting landscape of the gulf, with beautiful views stretching from the Grado and Lignano Sabbiadoro lagoons to the Istrian coast.

AT THE TOP OF THE ALPS

The Golf Club Senza Confini Tarvisio, designed initially by Giacomo Cabrini in 1992, was expanded in 2003 to 18 holes by the Canadian architect Graham Cooke, who oversaw the restyling. It offers a course with two distinct souls. The first 9 holes develop along some more or less demanding slopes among the beautiful woods of the Tarvisio forest. The second 9 holes,

including some water features, stretch mainly over flat territory. Here, the extensive greens are sometimes hidden among pine and beech trees, often protected by bunkers or, even more remarkably, by dizzying depressions, making it difficult to approach even for the most experienced golfers.

To complete the mountain offer is also the **Golf Club Sappada**, which in an enchanted context offers a remarkable green with nine holes to practice this passion even in the fairy-tale setting of the Dolomites.
