



A calendar of 150 food&wine experiences for the wine tourist:

in Friuli Venezia Giulia for a gourmet holiday along the Route of Wine and Flavours

Picnics among the vineyards or orchards, concerts in the wine cellars, meditation among the vine rows, family moments in the countryside, tastings in the lagoon: PromoTurismoFVG, with the collaboration of Movimento Turismo del Vino del Friuli Venezia Giulia, (Wine Tourism Movement of Friuli Venezia Giulia) has published the wine and food proposals of the territory online

Trieste June 29, 2021 - From June to October along the Strada del Vino e dei Sapori (The Route of Wine and Flavours) of Friuli Venezia Giulia, it will be possible to choose from 150 integrated food and wine experiences. You can spend a day in the name of tasting and discovering the food&wine traditions of the region in unique naturalistic scenarios such as the vineyards of the main Doc (Denomination of Controlled Origin) areas, the malga pastures of the mountain area, the nature reserves and lagoons, the Gulf of Trieste, orchards and olive groves, where the excellence of the territory is born. The classic tastings will always be combined with activities and proposals integrated with other experiences of the territory designed to make the products and their places of production known: concerts in the wine cellars with Art&Taste, outdoor picnics with Pic&Taste, experiences among the vineyards at the weekends of Cantine e Vigneti Aperti, tastings on board a boat sailing the lagoons with Sea&Taste, mindfulness among the vineyards with Nature Bathing, captivating activities for children with Family&Taste and a day of harvesting among the scent of grapes and must with Harvest&Taste.

Art&Taste

The wine cellars and breweries of Friuli Venezia Giulia become the stage of live music shows with the Art&Taste format: six events where you can attend concerts and at the same time taste a glass of wine or beer accompanied by local products of the territory. The event starts on July 11 in the Foffani wine cellar in Trivignano Udinese with the "Experimental Violin and Piano Sonata". It continues on July 25 in the Zorzettig wine cellar in Cividale del Friuli, where you can enjoy the performance of "Dena De Rose Quartet feat Piero Odorici" in the context of the Mittlefest 2021. On August 6 at the Villa Chazil brewery in Lestizza, it will be the turn of the "Duo Tzigano Daris D'Eusanio" while at the Pitars wine cellar in San Martino al Tagliamento the concert "Lost songs" by Bearzatti Casagrande will be held. Last appointment September 19 at the Modeano wine cellar with Les Babettes.

Sea&Taste

From the sea to the inland: those who choose Lignano Sabbiadoro, Grado, or the Trieste Gulf for a holiday on the 130 km of the region's coast can participate in excursions to discover tastes and nature. Sea & Taste offers experiences in nature reserves (from July 7), visits and tastings in wine cellars (from July 2), aperitifs at sunset in the Lagoons of Grado and Marano (from July 15) or on board a sailing ship in the Gulf of Trieste (from July 17). Also visits to the historic city of Aquileia, Unesco heritage (from July 6) or to some of "the most beautiful villages" in Italy such as Strassoldo and Valvasone (from June 30), canoe excursions under the Duino Castle (from July 1) or a fishing trip in Grignano (from July 1).
