

## Ortlieb Sets the Pace in the First Training Run: Immediate Great Spectacle in Tarvisio

The Austrian skier fastest on the Di Prampero in the opening downhill training. Delago the best Italian, Vonn seventh. Tomorrow the second and final official training ahead of the races, followed by global media coverage in more than 25 countries.

**Tarvisio, January 15, 2026** – Nina Ortlieb was the fastest in the first official training run of the women's World Cup downhill at the **Tarvisio Audi FIS Ski World Cup**, held today on the "Di Prampero" course. The Austrian skier finished 0.68 seconds ahead of Germany's Kira Weidle and 0.71 seconds in front of fellow Austrian Cornelia Huetter. Fourth, at 1.40 seconds back, was the best of the Italians, Nadia Delago, followed by another Austrian, Mirjam Puchner, in fifth place. Sixth was Andorra's Cande Moreno, seventh the "queen of Tarvisio" and of the Di Prampero course, American Lindsey Vonn, eighth the fourth Austrian Ariane Raedler, ninth the best Swiss skier Joana Haehlen, and tenth the American Allison Mollin. Other Italian skiers finished as follows: eleventh Laura Pirovano, seventeenth Nicol Delago, twenty-fourth Sofia Goggia, thirty-first Roberta Melesi, and thirty-eighth Elena Curtoni. Sara Thaler, Vicky Bernardi, Sara Allemand and Asja Zenere did not start.

### FULL TRAINING RESULTS

#### Friday's schedule

Tomorrow, Friday January 16, the action resumes with the second day of official training. [Here is the official start list](#).

The races will then take place over the weekend: on Saturday January 17 the Women's Downhill is scheduled to start at 10:45 a.m., while Sunday January 18 will conclude the event with the Super G, starting at 11:15 a.m. The event is promoted by the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region through PromoTurismoFVG, with the support of FIS, FISI, the Municipality of Tarvisio and the Tourism Promotion Consortium of Tarvisiano, Sella Nevea and Passo Pramollo.

#### Partnerships and food & wine

The Audi FIS Ski World Cup Tarvisio 2026 is made possible thanks to the support of a strong network of partners and internationally renowned sponsors. #### Media coverage – Where and how to follow the races

A total of 150 accredited media representatives will be present, including journalists, photographers, radio and TV crews, web media and local, national and international content creators. Seven television broadcasters (RAI, Eurosport, ZDF, ORF, RSI, SRF, RTV Slo) and one radio station (ORF) will provide live commentary on site, using the images supplied by Infront, the event's media partner, rights holder and producer of the two races. The event will enjoy unprecedented international television coverage, with broadcasts guaranteed in more than 25 countries across Europe, Asia and the Americas, reaching a global audience of millions of viewers. In Europe, the event will be broadcast, among others, in Italy (RAI and Eurosport), Germany (ZDF), France and across Europe via Eurosport, Switzerland (SRG SSR), Finland (Viaplay), Sweden, Norway and Denmark (Viaplay), Slovenia (RTV Slovenija), Croatia (HRT), Slovakia (JOJ) and the Czech Republic (Czech TV). In Asia, live coverage will reach Japan (J-Sports), China and Macao (CCTV), Taiwan (ELTA) and Mongolia (NTV). In the Americas, the event will be broadcast in Canada (CBC), the United States (Ski and Snowboard Live) and throughout Latin America via ESPN. This extensive distribution confirms the global and international value of the event and strengthens its role as a major sporting and territorial showcase.

### Side events

The highlight of the weekend is Saturday January 17, dedicated to the Women's Downhill, scheduled at 10:45 a.m. on the Di Prampero course. After the race, starting at 2:30 p.m., the atmosphere will heat up in the Finish Area in Camporosso di Tarvisio with the official après-ski hosted by RTL 102.5: a major public party featuring hosts Angelo Baiguini, Jessica Brugali and DJ Sautufau, offering an afternoon of high-energy music and entertainment. In the evening, at 6:15 p.m., again in the Finish Area, the Downhill (DH) prize-giving ceremony will take place, followed by the Super G bib draw, a symbolic and eagerly awaited moment marking the handover to the next day's race. The event concludes on Sunday January 18 with the Women's Super G, scheduled at 11:15 a.m. on the Di Prampero course. After the race, the prize-giving ceremony will be followed by the final big celebration with RTL 102.5, bidding farewell in music to athletes, spectators and volunteers after an unforgettable weekend of international sport.
