

The Giro d'Italia on Mount Lussari

All the information on how to purchase a round trip ticket for the cable car and a parking space

For safety reasons, on May 27, the number of tickets available for visitors who want to reach the summit by cable car is reduced, and the arrival of cars into the car parks is divided into time slots.

It is very important and highly recommended that all visitors who wish to climb to the summit be **equipped with the appropriate clothing for alpine conditions**, given the extreme variability of weather that is typical for mountain areas.

<u>Please be advised that during the day, the teams and staff members have priority boarding in the cable car at all times.</u>

ROUND TRIP TICKETS FOR THE LUSSARI CABLE CAR

How many tickets are available? There are **3,000** tickets available for purchase and only through online sales. https://fvg.axess.shop/

When and at what time does the online sale open? The sale opens at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday May 16 and will be active subject to availability.

What are the parking access time slots associated with the tickets? When booking, it is mandatory to select the arrival time slot. There are 4 time slots and 750 parking spaces are available in each of them:

- 750 parking spaces from 8.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m.
- 750 parking spaces from 9.30 a.m. to 10.30 a.m.
- 750 parking spaces from 10.30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m.
- 750 parking spaces from 11.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

How much does the ticket cost? The ticket for the Lussari cable car costs EUR 22.00 for each person and it grants one round trip on May 27 2023.



Are there any reductions? The ticket is sold in one category only and there are no reductions available for specific age groups or other special categories. Children under 3 years of age are admitted free of charge if they are accompanied by a paying adult by presenting a valid identity document at the turnstile.

What is the validity of the ticket? The ticket is only valid for the event taking place on May 27 and it will be void afterwards if not used. It allows one outward and one return trip from the valley to the mountain on the Lussari cable car.

What information is required for purchase? Name, surname and date of birth of each person purchasing the ticket plus an e-mail address.

How much time do I have for each purchase transaction? The purchase must be completed within 10 minutes after the ticket has been placed in the shopping cart. Within this time frame, it is mandatory to enter the names, surnames and dates of birth of all persons who will access the facility. At the end of the transaction, you will receive a confirmation e-mail containing the purchase details and the QR code for direct access to the cable car.

How do I proceed if I do not receive the purchase confirmation e-mail? Check that the payment transaction was successful with your credit card company. If you have not received the confirmation e-mail with your ticket within 24 hours after your purchase, please contact skipass@promoturismo.fvg.it.

What happens if I have bought a ticket and cannot attend the event? The ticket purchased is nominal and cannot be refunded or used on another date. If you are unable to attend the event, you can replace the name on the ticket by sending a request to skipass@promoturismo.fvg.it. Please wait for our e-mail reply, which you will have to present at the turnstile.

How do I access the cable car on the day of the event? After your purchase you will receive a QR CODE for access by e-mail; you can decide whether to print it out on paper and present it at the entrance to the cable car or display it directly on your mobile device. Access is permitted during the time slot you have reserved. A valid identity document must be presented together with the ticket in order to verify that the name on the ticket corresponds with the right of



access. In the event of a mismatch, remember that you will not be able to access the event and will not be entitled to a refund.

When do I receive the complimentary gadgets? The cape and cap with the IO Sono Friuli Venezia Giulia and the Giro d'Italia logos are handed out at the entrance to the cable car.

RESERVED PARKING SPACE

In addition to the ticket for the cable car, it is also possible to purchase a reserved parking space. This type of parking space is reserved exclusively for holders of a ticket for the Lussari cable car.

How many parking spaces are available for visitors who purchase the cable car service? 1,000

How much does the parking space cost? EUR 3 for each vehicle

What types of vehicles are allowed in these parking spaces? The parking area is predominantly on grass or gravel. Cars and motorbikes are granted access. Camper vans and/or caravans are not allowed, which can instead use the dedicated parking spaces listed in the Giro d'Italia Tarvisio app.

How do I access my reserved parking space? By May 25 we will send you an e-mail specifying the name of the car park allocated to you and instructions on how to access it. You will need to arrive in good time to access the facility during the time slot you have reserved.

What parking spaces are available for people with disability? Parking for people with disability is free in the centre of Tarvisio in Via Vittorio Veneto, Via Valcanale and Via Lussari.

CABLE CAR TIMETABLE

On May 27, the cable car is open in private service from 8 a.m. to midnight approximately. Only regular ticket holders are allowed access.

At what time can I go up? The upward trip is permitted during the reserved time slot.

What time can I go back down? The cable car operates throughout the day. Please be advised that the teams and staff members have priority boarding the cable car at all times.

SPECIAL ACCESS TO THE CABLE CAR

Are dogs allowed on the cable car? Yes, dogs are admitted free of charge provided they are on a leash and have a muzzle.

I have a pushchair or pram, can I travel on the cable car? Yes, equipment for children is admitted free of charge.

I am a person with disability, how do I access the lift? People with disability can access the cable car with their nominal ticket in the reserved time slot and their equipment is admitted free of charge.

RESTRICTIONS FOR ACCESS TO THE CABLE CAR

It is not permitted to transport bulky sports equipment and large objects in general (for example, bicycles, paragliders, hang-gliders, musical instruments, camping equipment and other similar items) in the cable car, except for equipment for children and people with disability.

Additional information



The ticket is only valid for the round trip on the cable car and does not give access to the Hospitality area.

ACCESS ON FOOT

Is it possible to reach Mount Lussari on foot? Yes, it is possible to reach Mount Lussari on foot using the paths: the Track A path and the Pilgrim's Path. PromoTurismoFVG declines any and all liability regarding access to Mount Lussari, except for users of the cable car installation.

Where on the slopes can I watch the race? From the summit, head down for approximately 3 kilometres; from Val Saisera, head up for the first 3 kilometres. It is not possible to enter and stand in the central part of the final climb.

INFORMATION ON THE COMPETITION AND BIG SCREENS

The schedule for the time trial is set from 11.30 a.m. with the departure from the centre of Tarvisio and the arrival on Mount Lussari at 6.30 p.m. of the last competitor. These times may be subject to change.

The maxi screens through which the race can be followed are positioned:

- 1 in Tarvisio
- 2 in the centre of Malborghetto Valbruna
- 1 high up on Mount Lussari at the finish line
- 1 at the cable car departure point
