### 130 KILOMETRES OF COAST... **AND HOLIDAYS**




From Lignano Sabbiadoro to the Marano and Grado Lagoon, passing through the Stella River and San Giorgio di Nogaro, continuing towards Grado, Aquileia and Monfalcone until you reach the Bay of Sistiana, Trieste and then Muggia: the coast of Friuli Venezia Giulia is a **paradise for boat lovers** 

and tourists who prefer the sea to the streets. Choose from marina resorts equipped with swimming pools and wellness services, suggestive spaces for mooring mega yachts and houseboats, but also a **dry marina for the storage** of your boat on dry land and a **team of craftsmen** with a high level of know-how for maintenance and repairs.

The moorings and berths are excellent starting points to sail off and discover a unique territory full of points of interest and personalised offers for skippers of all levels.

# **EXPERIENCES... OF COURSE FREE**

Not only sea, not only beaches. For those who love the facets of the world around you and love to share feelings with people you love, the Friuli Venezia Giulia Coast is the ideal destination. A mix of experiences in contact with nature, such as those you can enjoy within the River Stella Mouth Nature **Reserve**, only accessible by water. And then take advantage of the many boat tours, explore the reed beds at a slow pace, dedicated to **birdwatching** and evoke ancient history, among the authentic Casoni (fishermen's huts). You may not know it, but Lignano Sabbiadoro is also one of the first seaside resorts in Italy where you can enjoy wellness experiences in the marine forests, which it is rich in and for which it is already known.



From the Valle Canal Novo Nature Reserve to the guided tour on SUP, canoe or boat from the bay Valle Cavanata Nature Reserve, passing through of Sistiana, or choose trekking on trails along the the **River Isonzo Mouth Reserve**. Arm yourself with binoculars and a camera and hide in the observation huts in the various Regional Nature Reserves to admire the unique spectacle of colourful birds in their natural habitat.

Do not miss the experience with the **herd of** white Camargue horses in the Nature Reserve Foci dell'Isonzo, which children will love especially thanks to the activities of approaching horses and ponies. Unique in its kind, the spectacle of white rock walls overlooking the sea in the **Nature Reserve of the Duino Cliffs**. Explore it with a

coast, such as the famous path of Rilke. And for sea explorers, in the Miramare Marine Protected Area, you can discover a rich biodiversi ty and do sea-watching, with the WWF staff, which in summer organises guided tours during the day or at dawn to discover the marine world! Remember, the fascinating caves that populate the Karst are also worth a visit: First of all the **Giant** Cave, with the majestic Great Cavern, which is world-renowned for its exceptional dimensions and then why not, the smallest but always evocative Grotta Torri di Slivia: a true spectacle of nature!



# **FUN HAS NO AGE**

Holidays with children are always great fun, but it is the Friuli Venezia Giulia Coast that makes

them even more surprising. Spend your family moments among beach attractions, dancing, games, attractions and theme parks.

On warmer days, the water parks such as Aquaplash and the Thermal Park Riviera Resort in Lignano Sabbiadoro and the **Water Park** of Grado are an explosive mix of dives, slides, swimming pools powered by seawater, artificial waves and trampolines.

A must-see stop for those who love nature? The Punta Verde Zoo Park in Lignano Sabbiadoro which welcomes young and old with over one hundred species of animals, itineraries for young

explorers and special close encounters with lemurs, sloths, giraffes and turtles of the Seychelles. I Gommosi is the inflatable playground for children, a place of fun and jumps immersed in the pine forest of the "Park of the Sea" of Lignano Sabbiadoro!

The **Junior Park of Lignano Sabbiadoro** is a concentration of thrills for the family, among jeep safari and swan lake, roller dragon, cinema 5D and much more, while in the evening, among lights and colours, the **Luna Park Strabilia** stands out. And how not to "drop by" the Trieste Adventure Park, which offers different routes made of lianas, launches into the air, zip-line, and pulleys, without any limit and for all ages.



# WITH FLAVOUR WITH THE TASTE EXPERIENCES

Taste a delicious glass of wine in the cellar, savour the **fish freshly caught** after a canoe trip or by bike, and discover the traditional dishes of the **Lagoon** in one of the restaurants with port only accessible by boat.

ces. Perhaps you don't know that in Friuli Venezia Giulia, some of the best white wines in Europe are produced, along with excellent red wines. The variety of soils and climates led to the identification of nine regional Denomination of Controlled Origin areas, three interregional and four Denomination of Controlled and Guaranteed And then there is the IO SONO FRIULI VENEZIA

GIULIA brand, which guarantees territoriality, sustainability and traceability.



# **UNESCO SITE OF AQUILEIA AND PALMANOVA**

If you love history and culture, the UNESCO sites of Aquileia and Palmanova are the right places for you.

Stroll among the remains of the Roman forum, and enter one of the ancient domus and the complex of the Paleochristian Basilica with its spectacular floor.

But if, on the one hand, **Aguileia** will surprise you with its imperial beauty, the city fortress of **Palmanova** will impress you for the preservation of the Historical Park of the Bastions and for its unforgettable nine-pointed star shape.

Overlooking the coast, **Trieste** is an enchanting seaside city with a multicultural personality, intertwined with many traditions that still survive together today and that you can discover from land and water. An example is Piazza Unità d'Ita**lia**, the Habsburg square overlooking the sea that opens imperiously on the romantic promenade of the **Molo Audace** pier.

Why not arrive by sea, guided by the **Victory Lighthouse** that watches over the city? From the top of San Giusto Hill, you can then visit the Castle and the Cathedral. This city of coffee and art is also an important scientific centre and the ideal destination for a

Relaxation and well-being are imperative for holidays, and if you want to recharge your batteries, you just have to book a stay on the Coast of Friuli Venezia Giulia. And if you fancy a trip out of town, far above sea level, you cannot miss the Thermal baths of Arta in Carnia, where the benefits of the waters of the Pudia spring combine with the healthy climate of
