Since 2015, PromoTurismoFVG, the Regional Council of Associations of Persons with Disabilities and their families in Friuli Venezia Giulia and CRIBA (Reference Centre for the Removal of Architectural Barriers) collaborate in the project 'A Region for Everyone' to develop accessible and inclusive tourism throughout the region, making accessibility a widespread and permanent cultural element. The 'A MARE IL MARE' project has improved the hospitality and accessible tourist services of the entire coastal area of Friuli Venezia Giulia. The project engaged 8 municipal authorities, voluntary associations, people with disabilities and tour operators, who performed mapping, training and field testing and purchased specific materials and equipment. A further step towards an increasingly accessible and inclusive region: 'A Region for Everyone'.

# DUINO AURISINA

## THE ENCHANTING INSPIRATION OF POETS AND WRITERS

Overlooking the sea from the top of a cliff is Duino, a charming village and a popular tourist attraction. It is a place that has inspired poets and writers, such as D'Annunzio, Twain, and Rilke.

On the picturesque path overlooking the Adriatic, named after Rilke, you can enjoy a spectacular view that stretches as far as Sistiana, where there is a beautiful bay with a small harbour.

The castle is the home of the Princes della Torre e Tasso, and is open to visitors, together with its elegant garden. In reality, there are two castles: the few ruins of the older one, dedicated to the Sun god according to tradition, sit right on the edge of the cliff overlooking the sea.

The legend of the White Lady is another attraction worth a visit: a large white rock that is a reminder of a damsel who took her own life for love.

# THE OSMIZA EXPERIENCE

## RILKE PATH

The path named after the famous Bohemian poet Rainer Maria Rilke was opened in 1987 and stretches for 1,700 metres. It is an easy walk through the Falesie Nature Reserve with breathtaking views of the sea and the surrounding coastline. From the entrance to Duino there is an accessible route that leads up to a splendid panoramic terrace.





# GRADO

The town of Grado, connected to the mainland by a narrow strip of land, boasts an old town centre reminiscent of Venice, with small squares and narrow streets, overlooked by rows of picturesque fishermen's houses. The island also features a maze of islets that form its picturesque lagoon, offering a richly coloured scenery with the green of the lush vegetation and the blue of the Adriatic Sea.

Campo dei Patriarchi, in the old town, is dominated by the Basilica of Santa Eufemia and the adjacent Basilica of Santa Maria delle Grazie, the oldest in Grado. The city is known as the "Sunshine Island" for its three kilometres of south-facing beaches, bathed in sunlight from morning until evening. Its unique microclimate guarantees bright, sunny days throughout the year.

In the past, Grado was part of the domains of the Austro-Hungarian Empire and was much loved by the Habsburg aristocracy, who, from the 19th century, came to the island for the baths and the highly-valued marine spas that still today are the ideal place to regenerate body and spirit.

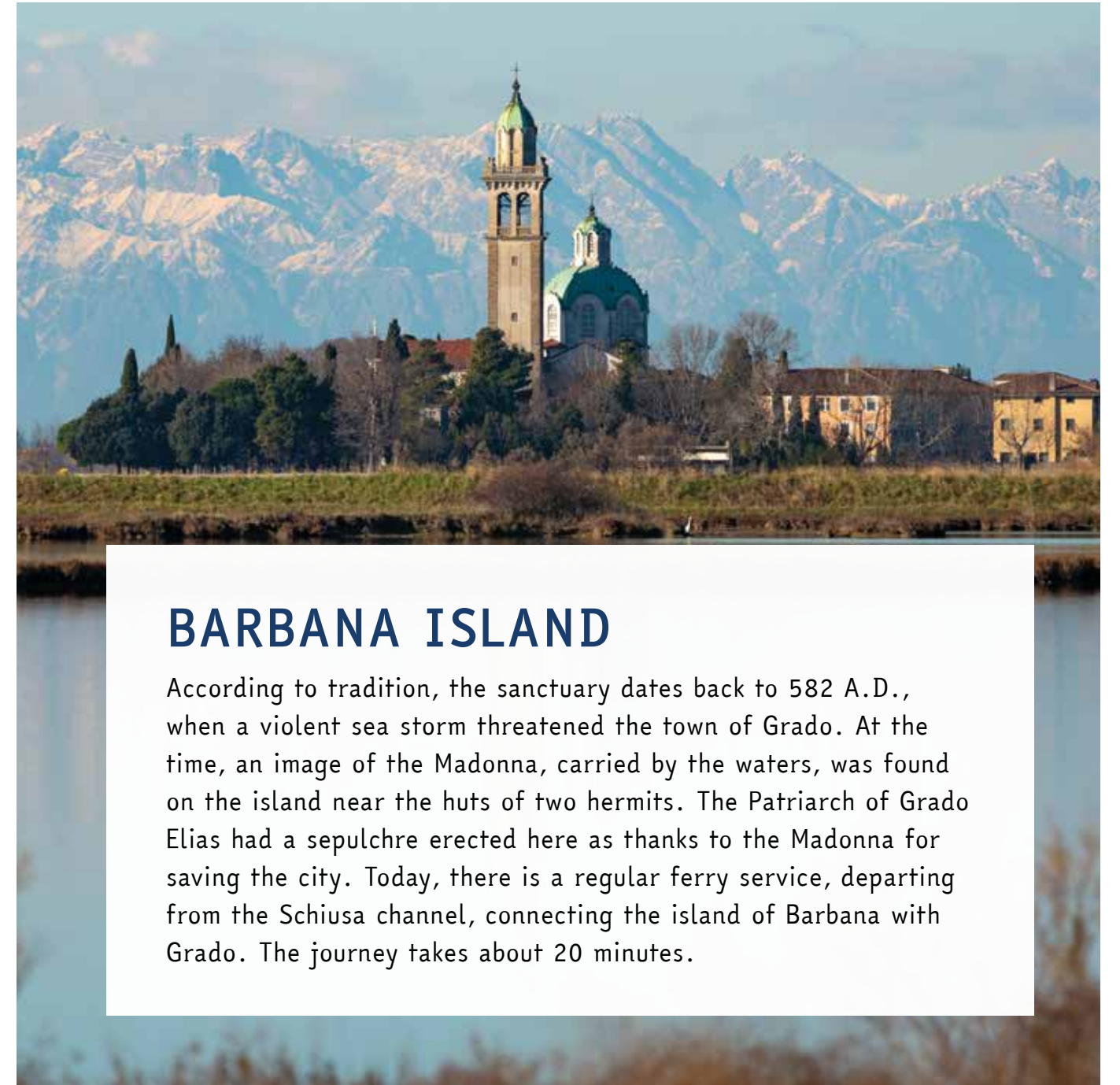


## IL BORETO A LA GRAISANA

Boreto a la graisana is the traditional Grado fisherman's dish.

Prepared with fresh fish cooked in extra virgin olive oil, it is seasoned with salt, pepper and a hint of vinegar, which gives it its strong flavour.

This was once a 'poor man's dish but is an incredibly tasty and authentic example of the local food.



## BARBANA ISLAND

According to tradition, the sanctuary dates back to 582 A.D., when a violent sea storm threatened the town of Grado. At the time, an image of the Madonna, carried by the waters, was found on the island near the huts of two hermits. The Patriarch of Grado Elias had a sepulchre erected here as thanks to the Madonna for saving the city. Today, there is a regular ferry service, departing from the Schiusa channel, connecting the island of Barbana with Grado. The journey takes about 20 minutes.



# LIGNANO SABBIAORO

Lignano Sabbiadoro boasts an 8 km stretch of golden sand, making it one of the most famous seaside resorts in Italy. The town is famous for its lively nightlife and endless entertainment throughout the summer season.

But Lignano Sabbiadoro has three distinct personalities. Sabbiadoro is perfect for shopping and nightlife, Pineta is the place for a quiet country holiday, and Riviera is a relaxing area with a rich vegetation of maritime pines. ## TERRAZZA A MARE

A long walkway leads to a belvedere with a small lighthouse suspended over the water, alongside a structure that from above looks like a fan-shaped shell, which has forever been an iconic symbol of Lignano Sabbiadoro for its spectacular sea views and the variety of leisure and entertainment opportunities it offers. A meeting place for generations, the Terrazza a Mare (Terrace by the Sea) has accompanied the development of the seaside town since the 1920s, when it was a simple wooden construction. In the 1970s it was rebuilt in cement and today it is ready for a new evolution.



# MARANO LAGUNARE

The Torre Millenaria dominates the horizon of Marano, a town that offers a unique and isolated experience, seeming a world within itself. Its secluded location is protected from the open sea by a cluster of islands and islets, such as Martignano and Sant'Andrea, also called the Island of Shells.

Until the end of the 19th century, the town was surrounded by walls; not even the Turks in the 16th century managed to invade it. The Venetian Republic, which ruled these lands from the 15th to the 18th century, tried hard to hold on to it, but respected local autonomy. The people of Marano, who are still grateful for their independence, boast that they are the only Friulian village where the people speak the Venetian dialect. In addition to creating a unique linguistic and cultural fabric, Venice also left a lasting architectural imprint on Marano.

The historic centre is a maze of intertwining calli (narrow streets) and piazzas. The houses overlook the streets, creating common outdoor spaces for meeting and working. The buildings are adorned with ornaments that tell the story of the city: bas-reliefs, stone faces and coats of arms.





# ART AND CULTURE



## MULA - ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM OF THE MARANO LAGOON

The MuLa (Archaeological Museum of the Marano Lagoon) is a fascinating museum that recounts the history and traditions of the Marano Lagoon through archaeological finds, historical evidence and interactive exhibitions.

The museum offers the opportunity to learn about the thousands of years of history of this unique area, which due to its position 'suspended' between sea and land was for centuries a strategic area for the passage of goods and a meeting point of cultures between the Adriatic and continental Europe.

## THE MARANO CASONI

The Marano casoni are the symbol of the lagoon: typical huts of Friuli Venezia Giulia and Veneto, which are exceptionally well preserved in Marano. It has a rectangular shape with rounded corners, covered with marsh reeds, a material abundant in the lagoon. Built with local resources such as common reed, black locust, elm and acacia wood, they rest on an artificial mud elevation, the mota, reinforced with boulders or piles taken from nearby canals.

There are two nature reserves within the Marano Lagoon:

- The **Stella River Mouth Reserve**, which covers the entire delta of the river, accessible only by sea.
- **Valle Canal Novo Reserve**, an area of about thirty-five hectares that in the past was used for fishing.

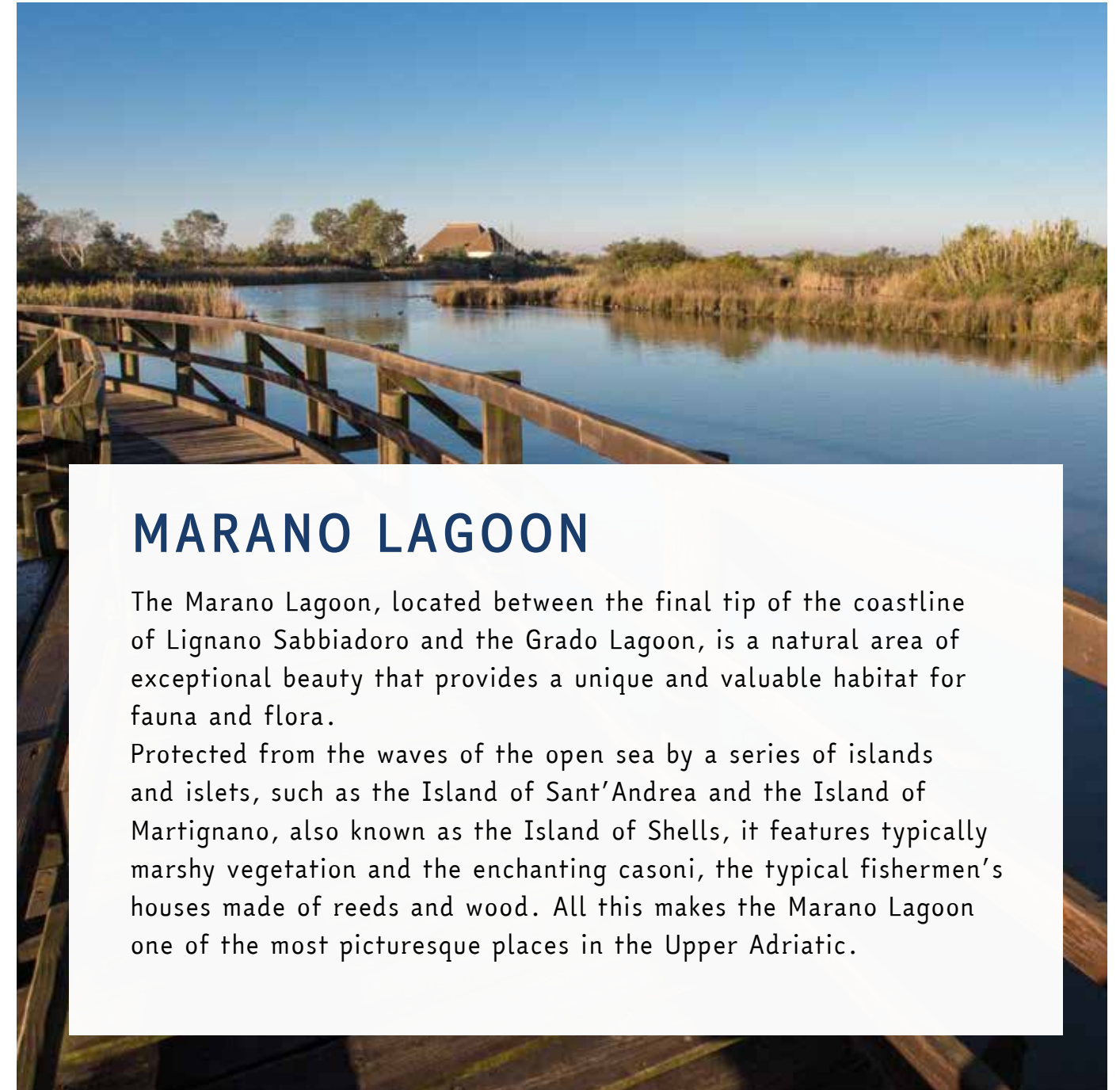
## A TOUR OF HISTORY, CULTURE AND LAGOON

The tour of Marano Lagunare is an enchanting journey through the cobbled streets and historic squares of this lagoon village. About 1 km long, it is perfect for discovering the authentic atmosphere, traditional architecture and history of the place. Strolling around, you can enjoy picturesque insights into the maritime culture and beauty of the Friulian lagoon.



# BISATO IN SPEO

Bisato in spèo, eel on the spit, is a traditional lagoon dish. The eel is cut into pieces, skewered with bay leaves and slowly roasted over embers. The result is meat that is crispy on the outside and soft on the inside, a reminder of ancient local culinary traditions.



## MARANO LAGOON

The Marano Lagoon, located between the final tip of the coastline of Lignano Sabbiadoro and the Grado Lagoon, is a natural area of exceptional beauty that provides a unique and valuable habitat for fauna and flora.

Protected from the waves of the open sea by a series of islands and islets, such as the Island of Sant'Andrea and the Island of Martignano, also known as the Island of Shells, it features typically marshy vegetation and the enchanting casoni, the typical fishermen's houses made of reeds and wood. All this makes the Marano Lagoon one of the most picturesque places in the Upper Adriatic.



# MONFALCONE

Monfalcone is not only an important industrial centre but also a city with a rich heritage, exemplified by the fortress. This medieval monument is a symbol of the city and home to the Palaeontology Museum, with exhibits covering more than 500 million years of geological history.

Near Monfalcone, visit the Great War Theme Park, which offers an immersive experience of the period between 1915 and 1918. Stroll along trenches and walkways and explore the open-air museums of the defence area of the Dolina dei Bersaglieri, San Martino del Carso and Monte San Michele. These parks are connected to cart tracks, trenches and official C.A.I. trails.

In the city centre, the Municipal Gallery of Contemporary Art is housed in the restored building of the old covered market. In 2004, it became part of the Association of Italian Contemporary Art Museums (AMACI). It is one of the largest exhibition spaces devoted to contemporary art in Friuli Venezia Giulia.

## SHIPBUILDING MUSEUM (MUCA)

## TOUR OF THE WORKERS' VILLAGE OF PANZANO

Strolling through the quiet streets and hidden courtyards, you can admire the characteristic industrial-style houses, which reflect a simple but hard-working life. The tour then moves on to the villas for office workers and executives, located in an area away from the centre of the district and differentiated from the workers' houses by the eclectic style and bright colours of the decorations. The tour gives you a true feeling of the authenticity of the place, discovering how it has evolved over time, between historical memory and rural beauty. It is the ideal experience for getting to know a lesser-known aspect of Friuli's history, off the beaten track.







## SARDONI IN SAVOR

Sardoni in savor is a traditional Friulian dish, typical of the coastal area, including Monfalcone.

The anchovies are fried, then immersed in a hot marinade of onion, vinegar, bay leaf and pepper, which gives the dish its characteristic sweet-and-sour flavour. This speciality originated as a method of preservation and is now a popular starter or main course.

## MEDIEVAL MUSEUM OF MONFALCONE

The Medieval Museum is located on the ground floor of Monfalcone Town Hall and was created following the discovery of several sections of the foundations of the medieval town walls and remains of the 13th-16th century settlement, which emerged during excavations for the restoration of the building. It is a true treasure of local history, which for centuries remained buried under the floor of the building until renovations began. There are also significant artefacts made of ceramics and glass, metal and bone, including an iron sword dating back to between the 14th and 15th century.

# MUGGIA

In the last strip of Italy, the coast seems to fold in on itself to create the Bay of Muggia, a characteristic Istrian-Venetian location. Landing in the picturesque dockyard, you almost feel as if you are entering right into the narrow streets and little squares. The Venetian atmosphere is not only evident in the architecture: the dialect, customs and culinary traditions also reveal an intense past shared with the republic.

Looking at Muggia from the sea, the white stones of Istria and colourful houses create a harmonious whole with the green Karst environment.

The scene is framed by seven kilometres of coastline and a crown of hills that overlook this vast area, which is shared between Italy and Slovenia. The village developed in the harbour before the year 1000, under the name of Borgolauro; in the 13th century, it became a municipality, with a cathedral and town hall built during the period.

The remains of the protohistoric castellieri (fortified settlements) of Santa Barbara and Muggia Vecchia provide evidence of a Roman and medieval past. These include the Basilica of Muggia Vecchia, dating back to the 9th century.





## ARCHPRIEST'S CATHEDRAL OF SAINTS JOHN AND PAUL

The Archpriest's Cathedral of Saints John and Paul, located in the heart of Muggia, is a remarkable example of medieval religious architecture.

Built in the second half of the 13th century on the site of an earlier church, it has a façade dating back to 1467 featuring a central rose window and a decorated lunette. The interior houses sacred works of art and historical testimonies of the local community.

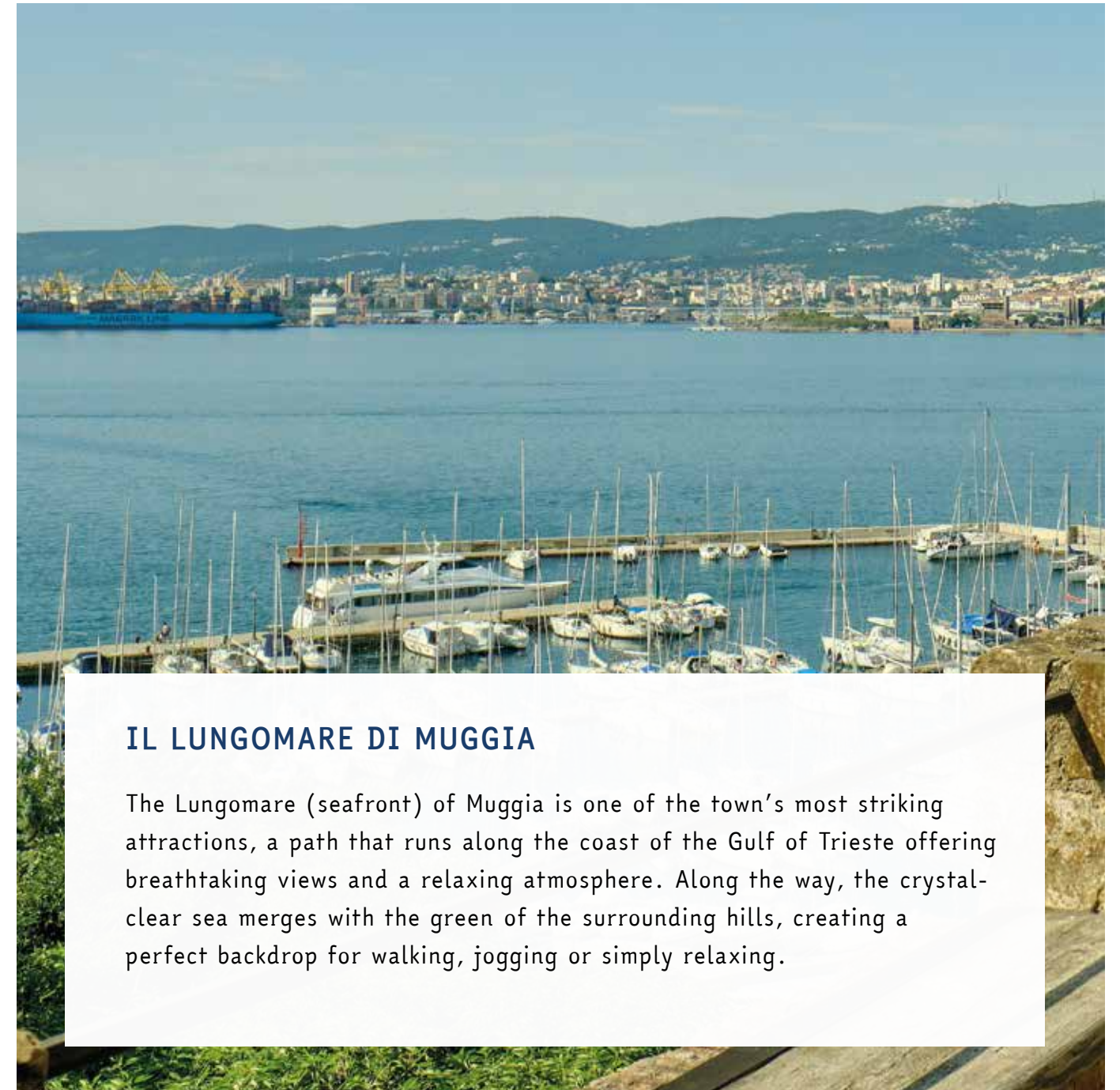




# SCAMPI ALLA BUSARA

## IL LUNGOMARE DI MUGGIA

The Lungomare (seafront) of Muggia is one of the town's most striking attractions, a path that runs along the coast of the Gulf of Trieste offering breathtaking views and a relaxing atmosphere. Along the way, the crystal-clear sea merges with the green of the surrounding hills, creating a perfect backdrop for walking, jogging or simply relaxing.



# STARANZANO

Staranzano, an ancient rural village dating back to Roman times, was initially part of the Podesterie of Monfalcone and San Pier d'Isonzo. In 1848, after the Vienna uprisings, it was granted municipal autonomy.

It later experienced economic difficulties and applied to be annexed to Monfalcone, from which it finally separated in 1907 by decree of Emperor Franz Joseph. Currently, it is home to one of the most important nature areas in the region: the Soča River Mouth Nature Reserve with the Cona Island Park.

The Lower Soča area, which includes the municipality of Staranzano, offers a variety of rural environments, including the sea, canals, the Karst region and a countryside rich in biodiversity. Take your time to explore Staranzano and its wonderful surroundings.





# NATURE SITES



## SOČA ESTUARY AND CONA ISLAND NATURE RESERVE

The Soča Estuary and Isola della Cona Nature Reserve is a protected area of extraordinary ecological importance, located in the eastern part of Friuli Venezia Giulia, along the final stretch of the River Soča.

This reserve covers an area of 2,338 hectares, 1,154 of which are in the marine area, including the municipalities of Staranzano, San Canzian d'Isonzo, Fiumicello and Grado.

Established in 1996, the reserve is recognised as one of the best birdwatching areas in Italy, hosting numerous species of both resident and migratory birds.

### MAIN FEATURES:

#### BIODIVERSITY:

The reserve is an ideal habitat for many animal species, especially birds. It hosts over 300 species of birds, including the Eurasian Curlew, symbol of the reserve

#### ACTIVITIES:

There are nature trails, wildlife observatories and guided tours to discover the local flora and fauna. Visitors can follow ring routes and longer paths, such as the United World Trail, which leads to the meadows of Biancospino, Mezza Cona and the Foce.

## TRIP TO THE ISONZO ESTUARY

The Soča Estuary route offers a lovely country walk through river and forest landscapes as far as the Lido di Staranzano (seafront). It is perfect for birdwatchers or a relaxing walk to enjoy the beauty of the surroundings and charm of the unspoilt beach.

The area is preserved through continuous environmental action and also entrusted to the animals themselves, such as the Camargue horses that live freely in the reserve and help keep the vegetation under control.



## MUSEO DIGITALE DELLA BONIFICA

The Museo Digitale della Bonifica - Idrovora Sacchetti (Digital Land Reclamation Museum) is dedicated to the history and techniques of agricultural land reclamation in the region. The museum is housed in the caretaker's house of the Idrovora Sacchetti pumping station in Staranzano, one of the drainage systems that in the 1930s made it possible to reclaim extensive stretches of swampland.

## ROSA DELL'ISONZO

The Rosa dell'Isonzo is a prized variety of radicchio, characterised by red leaves arranged in the shape of an open rose. You have to wait for low temperatures for this radicchio to develop, precisely because the cold is what gives it its distinctive green to red colour. Its delicate, slightly bitter flavour makes it ideal for use in traditional Friulian dishes.







# TRIESTE

Trieste is described as the most cosmopolitan city in Italy, with a Hapsburg history and a Mediterranean soul.

The heart of Trieste is Piazza Unità d'Italia, surrounded by historic buildings and overlooking the sea from the pier Molo Audace. The view includes monuments, churches and the impressive Miramare Castle in the distance. The city also boasts a coffee tradition, with literary cafés frequented by great authors. Visiting one of these cafés is a ritual not to be missed, where you can learn how to order an espresso in the local dialect. The borderland that is home to Trieste looks towards the Adriatic Sea and the Karst promontory, full of the fragrance of Mediterranean scrub. ## THE HISTORICAL CAFÉS OF TRIESTE

## TERGESTE OLIVE OIL

The Trieste Karst region produces Tergeste DOP extra virgin olive oil, a product that represents the perfect combination of tradition and terroir. The olive tree has grown in this area since pre-Roman times, thanks to the mitigating influence of the Adriatic Sea and the unique microclimate of the Karst region, which favours high quality cultivation. This oil is distinguished by its extraordinary organoleptic qualities, with a flavour that is delicate yet persistent, enriched by pleasant notes of green tomato, making it ideal for enhancing traditional Mediterranean dishes.



## CASTLE OF MIRAMARE

The Castle of Miramare was built between 1856 and 1860 as a residence for Archduke Ferdinand Maximilian of Habsburg, later to become Emperor of Mexico, and his wife Charlotte of Belgium. There are more than 20 rooms inside the castle, including the 'Maximilian Rooms', such as the bedroom furnished like a ship's cabin and the 'Throne Room'. To make the experience accessible to all, the museum provides educational aids in Braille, tactile panels with maps and raised texts, and an illustrated tactile guide telling the history of the castle and park in an inclusive manner.
