FROM THE LITORANEA VENETA COASTAL WATERWAY TO LIGNANO SABBIDORO - ALL THE NUANCES OF THE SEA




Lignano Sabbiadoro is a seaside resort that combines sea, nature and fun for all ages.

It is renowned for the wide range of tourism, including family holidays, glittering night-life, relax on the sea, parks, zoos and attractions. 'Sabbiadoro' means 'golden sand', a name Lignano certainly owes to its well-equipped golden sandy beaches that are ideal for water sports such as windsurfing, SUP, kite surfing and kayaking. You can also enjoy wellness experiences immersed in nature, such as metabolic walking, nordic walking, forest bathing and yoga.

Golf lovers will be astonished by Lignano Sabbiadoro's wonderful golf courses, while the most demanding explorers will have to choose among the many bike tours and cycling routes to discover both the coastline and the hinterland.

Right next to Lignano Sabbiadoro is **Aprilia Marittima**, an important reference point for yachting, with berths, dry marinas, marina resorts and many other services for sea lovers.

Not far away from here lie **Redipuglia** and **Monte San Michele**, two places preserving the memory of the world wars, and the wild scenery of the Karst with the **Doberdò and Pietrarossa Lakes Nature Reserve**.



FROM DUNO TO SISTIANA LEGENDS OF THE SEA

Among the white cliffs overlooking the Upper Adriatic, **Duino** reveals a coastline of breathtaking views and ancient myths. On a cliff overlooking the bay you can meet the **White Lady**, whose soul lives here and whose legend makes these places even more fascinating.

The **Duino Castle**, perched above the sea, dominates **Sentiero Rilke** trail, a scenic route that

inspired the Austrian poet's famous elegies. In the **Duino Cliffs "Falesie di Duino" Nature Reserve**, you can walk among pine trees and peregrine falcons and join the lively **Sistiana Bay**, the nearby **Canovella** and **Santa Croce** beaches (mainly rocky or pebbly), the **Costa dei Barbari** (FKK) beach and, finally, **Portopiccolo**, a luxury but environmentally sustainable resort.

FROM THE LAGOON TO MARANO LAGUNARE A TREASURE OF SEAFARING CULTURE AND BIODIVERSITY

In the **northernmost Lagoon in the Mediterranean** is a village made up of small lanes, small squares and bas-reliefs that tell the century-long history of Venice.

The Lagoon, protected by islands and canals marked by the typical briccole (dolphin pilings), is a rare example of balance between man and nature, so much so that it is the seat of two **Regional Nature Reserves - Foci dello Stella and Valle**

Canal Novo - were herons, swans and hawks live and where you can find traditional fishermen's cabins called casoni as well as traditional bilancioni, fishermen's huts equipped for called for fishing in the river and still in use. **Marano Lagunare** is also the gateway to Palazzo dello Stella natural oasis and **San Giorgio di Nogaro** nautical centre, in an area where **water, history and biodiversity** blend harmoniously.



FROM GRADO TO AQUILEIA THE ISLAND OF THE SUN AND UNESCO SITES

The islands of Barbana, Anfora, Mota Safon and Banco D'Orto are a sort of introduction to the beauty of **Grado**, also known as the Island of the Sun because of its privileged position. Each of these islands has its distinguishing feature. Barbana is home to an ancient sanctuary dedicated to the Virgin Mary; Anfora and Francamela host a renowned fish restaurant; Mota Safon was the setting for Pierpaolo Pasolini's film 'Medea' starring Maria Callas; Banco D'Orto is a strip of golden sand, a corner of unspoilt nature, where many species of marsh birds nest.

In Grado, nature, history and tradition inter-twine. Amidst canals and verdant islets lie the Marine Thermal Baths, seaside spa, the basilica of Santa Eufemia, and the lively Porto Mandracchio. In the alleyways, you can breathe in the art of ancient crafts, while in the trattorias you can enjoy local fish dishes. The beach is safe and hospitable, ideal for **families and sports lovers**, with activities such as sailing, SUP and windsurfing.

Grado is the arrival point of the **Alpe Adria Cycle Route**, and nearby are two important UNESCO sites: **Aquileia**, renowned for its Roman-era archaeological site, and **Palmanova**, the star-shaped fortress town.

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Overlooking the sea and framed by the green Karst landscape, **Muggia** is the only town on the Istrian peninsula located in Italy that preserves the soul of the Serenissima in its streets, palaces, Muggia dialect and traditions, both gastronomic and those related to customs and traditions, such as the **Carneval de Muja**. Behind it, the Val Rosandra valley offers spectacular scenery: waterfalls, caves and white cliffs loved by hikers. Muggia is in fact the final stop on the **Alpe Adria Trail** and the **Via Flavia**, combining faith, nature, and the sea.
